

- The equipment and person(s) operating/assisting the specialized adaptive skiing equipment must be able to control and stop the equipment in compliance with the Skier Safety Code and State law. _____ Ski Area will not require person(s) operating/assisting specialized adaptive skiing equipment to take or pass any skills or competency tests, but may generally observe such person(s) while skiing to verify their ability to control and stop the equipment in compliance with the Skier Safety Code and State law
- Disabled skiers may use a guide or personal assistant in order to ski safely, negotiate the lifts, or meet other conditions of the Skier Safety Code and State law. Guides and personal assistants are considered part of that skier's equipment, will not be charged for a separate lift ticket (when skiing with the person with a disability), may utilize specialized equipment similar to that being used by the disabled skier to assist in training and learning of adaptive skiing techniques, and must be allowed wherever the disabled skier is allowed.
- _____ Ski Area offers or will arrange for rental of any specialized adaptive skiing equipment, or for skiing lessons for any specialized adaptive skiing equipment, when requested in advance by disabled individuals. The usual _____ Ski Area charges for general public ski rentals or lessons apply to adaptive ski rentals and lessons.
- _____ Ski Area will provide any additional reasonable accommodations requested by the disabled individuals which will allow such person(s) to successfully use all ski lifts, ski runs, and other resort facilities.
- Proof of disability may be required. State-issued disability parking placards, a Federal disability Access Pass, other government-issued proof of disability cards, a written representation of disability prepared by a qualified medical practitioner, or a verbal representation by the skier which is not contradicted by observable fact, shall all be accepted as a credible assurance that the skier has a qualifying disability.

This policy is in accordance with the American with Disabilities Act [USC, Title 42, Ch. 126, §12182(b)(2)(A)(ii)], and _____ State laws, which requires reasonable modifications in rules, practices, or procedures, to provide disabled persons full and equal access to all goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages, or accommodations, which the _____ Ski Area offers the general public.
